Lucy C. Vance Center

The Vance Center is designed to improve the coping and functioning skills of lowincome children, adults, and families by providing counseling services. The counseling program helps children, youth, and adults:

- Heal from emotional pain and trauma
- Stabilize mental health symptoms
- Develop coping skills to deal with life stressors
- Strengthen family & social relationships
- Services: Counseling Psychiatry & Nursing (Ages 0-21) Case Management Skill Building Peer Support

Navigator Services

Families First's Navigator Services offer intensive, wrap-around support to help families address complex challenges, connect to essential resources, and build lasting stability.

- ♦ Personalized case management before crises arise
- → Connection to resources including housing, employment, and health
- ◆ Two-generation approach supporting parents and children
- Programs: TeenAge Pregnant & Parenting Program (TAPP) and Chispa Early Learning

Parenting & Adoption Support

Continuing our 135-year legacy of caring for vulnerable children and families. Families First provides a variety of parenting and adoption support services.

- ◆ Facilitates effective parenting by offering supervised visitation, mediation, and education classes
- Provides training to foster, kinship, and adoptive parents to support children who've experienced trauma
- Strengthens post-placement adoptive, guardianship, and kinship families through resources and education
- Programs: Parenting Time, Partners in Parenting, NTDC Hub, Georgia Center for Resources & Support

FY24-25 IMPACT

1,777 counseling sessions were provided to **241** individuals





49% of clients showed progress on their treatment goals



Navigators made 968 home visits and conducted 104 Play & Learn sessions for 45 families participating in the program
